This is a new volunteer role for the council and has arisen as a result of an increasing number of people unable to tend their graves as they would like. From the 1 January 2022 as part of the commitment to the environment plastic of any kind will not be permitted in the cemetery.

The Cemetery Volunteer will very much be part of a team committed to ecology whilst meeting the needs of the bereaved and visitors to the cemetery.

- To support a pleasant and peaceful environment with ease of maintenance
- To respect the dignity of this peaceful and tranquil place.
- To greet visitors and provide directions around the grounds.
- To assist the grounds staff in managing the flower beds, pots and planted areas
- To dispose of objects, materials, plants, wreaths, and flower containers which have died.
- To remove litter from the open space to the bins provided.
- To assist grave remove invasive species such as ivy from walkways & hedgerows.
- To inform the Town Council where they are aware that cemetery regulations are being breached.
