ROLE PROFILE

OBJECTIVE: As a Conservation volunteer you will support Hedge End Town Council to help maintain the woodlands, open spaces, and urban wilderness within Hedge End TC's portfolio of land.

Activities take place in all weathers throughout the year may include coppicing, pruning, scrub clearance, pond maintenance, litter picking, surveying, repairs to fences etc.

Conservation Volunteers should enjoy working outdoors, be physically fit, interested in environmental improvements in their local area, or perhaps have an interest in wildlife and conservation.

DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE TO: Operations Manager

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To support conservation works within Hedge End.
- To work within designated areas (as assigned) and carry out tasks set by HETC staff.
- To follow the instruction of Hedge End TC staff in the safe use of hand tools and equipment.
- To ensure that clothing is worn suitable for the time of year and the activities undertaken.
- To be aware of others and their surroundings during activities.

- Experience of conservation work or similar.
- Be physically fit and able to work on uneven surfaces.
- Enjoy meeting people and being part of a team.
- Experience of using basic hand tools.
- Have an interest in conservation or similar.
