T/20/87888, 51 Walker Gardens, Hedge End. 1 no. oak - Reduce crown back by 5.5m. **RESOLVED: Objection on the basis that large pruning wounds may be an ingress for pests and disease which may have a negative impact on the tree's health.** 

H/20/87953, Northwood, 97 Lower Northam Road, Hedge End. Two storey rear extension, rear conservatory, addition of first floor side facing windows & velux windows to side & rear roof slopes. **RESOLVED: No Objection.** 

H/20/88000, 33 Bursledon Road, Hedge End. Two storey rear extension and removal of side entrance porch. **RESOLVED: No Objection.** 

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T/20/87827, 4 Brunel Close, Hedge End. 1 no. Oak (T1) - reduce tree by up to 2 metres over house and garden. 1 no. Oak (T2) - reduce over garden by up to 2 metres. **RESOLVED: No Objection subject to the usual conditions of the tree officer.** 

T/20/87952, Sunnyside, Heath House Lane, Hedge End. 2 no. oak (T1 & T4) - Crown lift to 5-6 metres and remove epicormic growth. 5 no. oak (T2, T3, T5, T7 and T8) – Fell. 1 no. oak (T6) - remove epicormic growth. 2 no. oak (T9 & T10) - Crown lift to 5 - 6 metres. Reduce over extended laterals by 2-3 metres and remove epicormic growth. **Objection to T2, T3, T5, T7 and T8 as insufficient evidence to support felling.** 

T/20/87991, Locke Road Play Area, Hedge End. 1 no. Oak (T1) - Overall crown reduction of up to 3 metres and crown raise to a maximum of 5 metres. **No Objection subject to the usual conditions of the tree officer.** 

H/20/88025, 40 Strawberry Fields, Hedge End. single storey side and rear extension. **RESOLVED: No Objection.** 

T/20/87918, Woodhaye, Netley Hill Estate, Hedge End. 1 no. Yew (T1) -Prune to clear utility wire by 1 metre. No Objection subject to the usual conditions of the tree officer. Clarity on the trees that are covered by the TPO in this area.

H/20/88051, 73 Bursledon Road, Hedge End. Single-storey and first floor rear extension; first floor and two-storey side extension; two-storey, single-storey and first floor front extension with new 1.2m high wall to front boundary. **RESOLVED: No Objection.** 

H/20/88080, 20 Gresley Gardens, Hedge End. Single storey rear extension following removal of conservatory. **RESOLVED: No Objection.** 

F/20/88079, Land to the rear of 82 St Johns Road, Hedge End. Erection of 1no. detached four-bedroom bungalow provided with associated access, car parking, amenity space and storage facilities. **RESOLVED: Objection on the basis of overdevelopment.**
