T/19/85004, 23 Netley Firs Road, Hedge End. 1 x Laurel (T1) - Removal of the branch on the fence and reduce remaining upright growth by 0.90 - 1.2m. 1 x Leyland Cypress Hedge (T2)- Reduce height by approximately 2.4m and trim side. 1 x Norway Maple (T3) - Re Pollard to old points. **RESOLVED: No objections subject to the usual conditions as specified by the tree officer.**
