The clerk is instructed to action/report the following:

- Vehicles parking on the grass verge at 71 Upper Northam Road, impeding grass cutting.
- Freegrounds Avenue/Sherborne Way junction vehicles are parking on the immediate corner of this junction and obscuring sight lines for motorists.

 Could a safe crossing be provided for pedestrians? This is a particularly dangerous site with regards to road safety for pedestrians, particularly with speed of cars leaving the M27 to reach the Hedge End Retail Park.
- Tollbar Way/Botley Road/Bradbeer Roundabout exit to Tollbar Way towards
 North Hedge End. Could a safe crossing be provided for pedestrians crossing from
 TK Max to Bradbeer side of Tollbar Way. The roundabout creates a considerable
 amount of traffic, often fast moving entering this point of Tollbar Way to reach
 North Hedge End. A traffic light controlled crossing is strongly recommended.
