H31 Planning Applications

F/15/77244 – 5a Lower Northam Road, Change of use from A1 (Retail) to A5 (hot food takeaway), installation of extractor ventilation system and flue. **RESOLVED: Objection.** The plan is not in keeping with the local area and there is a proliferation of food and hot food outlets in Hedge End.

F/15/77145 – 229 Cranbourne Park, First floor side extension **RESOLVED: No Objection.**

F/15/77158 – 24 Hobb Lane, Addition of 1no. front & 1no. side facing dormer window **RESOLVED: No Objection**

H32 Highway Matters

Cllr. Paul Carnell reported on the serious flooding on Freegrounds Avenue by the Co-op car park that requires urgent attention. He commented that the pathway outside 151 Cranbourne Park requires attention and the footpath between Bergen Crescent and Cranbourne Park is in need of brushing and maintenance.

Cllr. Chris Yates reported on the danger of the hazard of car parking along Turnpike Way and felt that in the interests of health and safety, a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) for an extension of double yellow lines be requested. He has also observed that at the junction of Firs Drive/Netley Firs Drive, there is an overgrown bush that requires maintenance.

Cllr. Helen Corben reported that at the bottom of Freegrounds Avenue along the new pavement recently constructed, there is significant vegetation in need of urgent maintenance for the sake of safe passage for the pedestrian user.

Cllr. Cynthia Garton reported on a tree that has fallen, lying on the grass verge between Peppercorn Way with the junction with Maunsell Way/Tollbar Way that requires attention. She also requested that 30mph repeater signs be requested along Maunsell Way as the traffic speeds along this road are high.

H33 To consider the feasibility and potential of hiring bicycles and creating strategically placed cycle stations around Hedge End

The Chairman reported that this project was raised at the last Strategy Committee meeting and was referred to the Highways & Planning Committee to develop. The Town Clerk advised that Richard Pemberton (Sustainable Transport Manager) should be approached to which members agreed and requested that enquiries be made and that an update report be given at the November full meeting of the Highways & Planning Committee. Members felt that, initially, perhaps five bicycles could be commissioned with possible corporate sponsorship. Additionally, members raised the matter of logistics and liability implications that needed to be considered.
