With effect from the close of business hours today, all communications have been checked for the receipt of apologies.

The Chair welcomed members of the public and moved that planning applications F/14/74388 and F/14/74213 should be considered at this stage of the meeting to allow residents to voice their concerns.

F/14/74388, 35 Bursledon Road. Construction of 3 storey building to accommodate six, 2 bed dwellings with associated car parking, bin stores, communal gardens and landscaping following demolition of existing building. Resolved: Objection. Out of keeping and not sympathetic to street scene. Overdevelopment. Traffic impact and serious parking issues both on and off site. Impact of height and light upon 37, Bursledon Road. Further comments: Cllr. Helen Corben requested that her personal full support of the objections raised by residents be recorded in these minutes. Members agreed that access both on site and within a congested street would be exceptionally difficult for the emergency services.

F/14/74213, Wildern School. Erection of portacabin for use as a modular classroom for a period of five years. Cllrs. Emma Norman and Paul Carnell declared an interest and withdrew from discussions. Inconclusive plans. With due consideration to the concerns of Mrs. Cardy of Rosemary Price Court, the Committee would wish to view the location of the proposed portacabin in relation to 2, Rosemary Price Court. The resident disputes the information contained within the plan.
