# 1. Albert Road Cemetery

- 4 interments have been undertaken since my last report, 3 full burial (2 of which were reopenings) and 1 interments of Ashes.
- The graves are always prepared to a high standard by our Groundstaff in all weathers and challenging conditions.

• The tree that I reported on last month and was due for removal fell apart during the recent strong winds, it beat us by 3 days!



#### 2. Allotments

• There are currently 3 vacant plots and a waiting list of 41, 12 of those are requests for second plots. The vacant plots are expected to be occupied quickly.

# 3. Bowling Green

 Repairs have taken place to the greens concrete edgers, this has been a creative solution and achieved using materials salvaged from our Depot stores at virtually no cost to the council. We can continue to make repairs, but they are not a fix and a more permanent solution will be required eventually.

## 4. Conservation Volunteers

- There was no volunteer session in February due to a shortfall in staff.
- The March session is due to take place in Home Farm Woodland. Work will primarily focus on removal of undesirable invasive non-native species – Rhododendron ponticum, Cherry Laurel and Portuguese Laurel, but will also include path clearance and litter picking.

### 6. Local Nature Reserve

2 Trees were removed following the recent storms; a large Poplar that had become
destabilised at the root and was leaning towards a property, and an Alder that had snapped off
at the base and was hung in an adjacent tree.

## 8. Open Spaces

#### a) Aspen Close

A large dead Willow has been removed this week from the woodland. The tree was over 22
meters tall but has been dead now for over a year. Most of the timber will remain on site to help
support the local ecosystem.

#### b) Dowds Farm

- Play Area awaiting various repairs from the installer including replacement of the rotating carousel, repair to the framework of the aerial runway and various small parts that need repair.
- A large Maple was brought down by the recent storms. The tree was cleared by HETC and now only the stump remains, this will be left to decay providing a home for a wide variety of flora and fauna.





Woodland Trust trees have been planted by HETC staff along Wellstead Way to form a hedge
that will act as a replacement for the current knee rail fencing. The aim is that as the knee rail
fencing decays and is removed the hedge will form a new impassable boundary and help
prevent unauthorised access to the open space.
