R129 Minutes & Matters Arising Meeting of 13 February 2019

The Minutes were signed and agreed as a true and correct record by the Chair. Councillors raised that there is an issue with CKH Utilities use of Rodaway and not being compliant with the agreement. **RESOLVED:** The Town Clerk to investigate and report back.

R130 Correspondence:

- (i) Hedge End Rangers requested the use of the Rodaway on Saturday Mornings, 30 March, 6 April, 4 May and 11 May 2019 for the under 17 girls team. **RESOLVED:** Subject to the pitch being playable councillors approved this.
- (ii) The Fitness Don requested the use of Rodaway grounds for bootcamp style fitness sessions on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday 9.30-10.30am and possibly 6.30-7.30pm. Donna outlined that the sessions would take place away from the football pitches. **RESOLVED:** That the proposal be agreed.
- (iii) Wildern Opportunity Group requested to:
 - Retain the 3rd shed and paint in a complementary colour to the fencing. **RESOLVED:** That this is agreed.
 - Paint the 2nd Shed in the same colour. **RESOLVED:** That this is agreed.
 - Paint the fencing in the original colours. RESOLVED: That this
 is agreed.
 - Provide Planters. **RESOLVED**: that a more suitable raised planter be considered to run alongside the wall.
 - Provide Sensory Boards. RESOLVED: That this be agreed subject to liaison with the Operations Manager on fixings.
 - Add leaf camouflage to metal shed. RESOLVED: That this is agreed.
- (iv) A resident contacted HETC regarding the Westward Road Play Area has a basketball court which when it rains its unusable due to the standing water. **RESOLVED:** The Town Clerk to ask the Operations Manager to explore the further.

R131 Allotments

- (i) Allotment Holders Sheds the Town Clerk outlined the work that the allotment committee had done on unauthorised sheds. Councillors agreed that the concerns were the grass greenhouse on plot F1. **RESOLVED:** That these are accepted with the exception of the green house on plot F1. The Operations Manager to investigate and advise.
- (ii) Request for a postbox to be installed at the allotments Chetana explained the rationale for having a postbox. Councillors were concerned that normal procedure would be for post to be sent to the treasurer as having a post box could invite unintended consequences and be subject to vandalism. Councillors suggested that the town council may consider receiving the post. The Town Clerk will explore this option. **RESOLVED:** The Allotment Holders to request this of the Treasurer in the first instance.

R132 Operations Manager Report

Albert Road Cemetery

- 6 internments since last R and A meeting 5 burial and 1 internment of ashes. Again, the burials have been completed by our own staff to a fantastic standard. It is not easy work.
- The Albert Road and War Memorial Green Flag judging will take place in April.

Allotments

- Amended T and C's will begin on April 15th. At this time a combination lock will be installed.
- There are currently no empty plots and a waiting list of 0.
- Councillors asked about the Disabled Allotment and Disabled Toilet.
 There has been no further correspondence on this, however the plots have been held.

Aspen Close Woodland

 A main sewage pipe has been damaged by a windthrown tree, this has caused damage to the pipe and Southern Water are repairing this. As part of the works some of the Crack Willow Trees have been felled.

Bowling Club

 There was an attempted break in through side gate causing minor damage which was reported to the police. It was repaired by Groundstaff.
