1. Apologies

2. Public Questions not on the Agenda

David Pateman of Upper Northam Road spoke to the meeting about the fencing that remains un-repaired on the property. The minutes from the time show that HETC put in the fencing. The resident felt that little support was given from the Town Council on this matter and that of the planning permission. The site is currently derelict as Eastleigh will not grant planning permission for a new build.

Councillors outlined that it isn't for HETC to give guidance to residents regarding planning permission. It is understood that Eastleigh has written to the resident as a result of the request for a site visit. Councillors outlined the history of the site which was bequeathed to the Town Council. Councillors suggested that if we are only considering two panels then it could be considered at the next Recreation & Amenities meeting.

A Councillor had received a call from a resident regarding the parking on verges in Westward Close.

A member of the public noted that there are a limited number of residents signed up to the police alert. Councillors agreed this should be promoted on the HETC social media. It was also agreed that this should go in the Gazette on a regular basis.
